## Monterey-Salinas Transit (MST) SERVICE CHANGES go into effect beginning Saturday, February 3rd

Line 7 (Monterey – Ryan Ranch): Major schedule changes with new routing. Line 7 will now serve the Monterey Courthouse.

Line 8 (Monterey – CHOMP): Major schedule changes with new routing. Will no longer serve the Monterey Courthouse or Merrill Gardens. Will now serve MPC Quad but will NOT travel through MPC on Via Lavandera.

Line 43 (Salinas – South Main via SVH): Schedule modification – additional late evening service on weekdays only. Please note: SVMH has been renamed SVH.

Line 44 (Salinas – Westridge): Major schedule modification. New schedule, and frequency will be increased to every 30 minutes.

Line 46 (Salinas – Natividad): Major schedule modification. New schedule, frequency will be increased to every 30 minutes and will operate later daily.

Line 61 (Salinas – VA DOD Clinic): Minor modification. Line 61 at Salinas Transit Center (STC) will now stop at Gate 8.

## **ACP Is Winding Down: FAQ for Constituents**

### **What Is Happening to the Affordable Connectivity Program (or ACP)?**

The Federal Government had set aside \$14.2 billion to help people afford high-speed internet through the Affordable Connectivity Program, which provides a \$30 credit to reduce the cost of internet service for eligible households. Depending on the service offering, some households utilized the credit to acquire internet service at no cost to them. Households that enrolled on or before February 7, 2024, will receive federal credits until the funding runs out.

The expected date for federal money to run out if congress does not provide additional funding, is April 2024.

### **When Will the Last Voucher Be Applied to a Participants Internet Bill?**

May 2024 is the last month for any level of support from the ACP. In April, enrolled households will receive their last full \$30 credit. In May, enrolled households will receive a partial credit, based on available federal funding.

### **How You Can Help Your Constituents?**

The ACP allowed your constituents to utilize the federal credit in a manner that best suited their household needs. Accordingly, the end of the program will impact each household differently. It is critical that your constituents contact their broadband provider, so they can determine the best next steps for them and their household. Generally, your constituents can choose to either a) apply for a low-cost plan for eligible customers, b) select a different service package, or c) cancel their broadband service plan.

Constituents received at least two notifications from their broadband provider detailing next steps. If your constituent is not able to locate one of those notifications, please direct them to:

- 1) Call the customer service number on their bill and ask to speak with a representative that can assist them with selecting an available option, or
- 2) Direct them to visit their providers website.

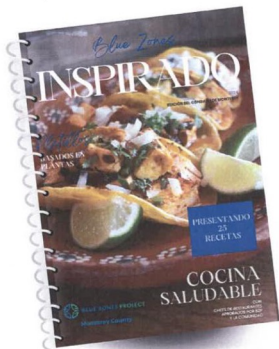

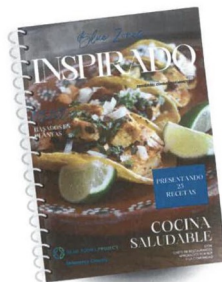

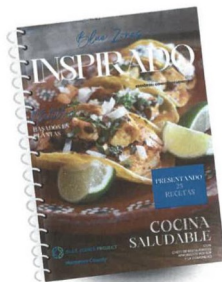
