### Conditions and Restrictions of Permit

1. Follow all provisions of the City Ordinance on Fireworks (attached).
2. File a Certificate of Insurance with the City Of Gonzales.
3. Location of stand and storage along with conditions of operation must be approved by Fire Marshal and Public Safety Director.
4. A sign must be posted per Section 9.16.30 of GMC, to read: No person shall light or cause or permit to be lighted any fireworks or other combustible article within any such stand or within ten feet thereof.
5. A fire extinguisher of at least 2 ½ gallon capacity in good working order and condition and of a type approved by the Fire Marshall must be maintained in the stand.
6. No sale of fireworks to anyone under the age of 18 years.
7. No one under the age of 18 years may sell fireworks.
8. Stand or sales location may not encroach upon public right-of-way.
9. Inspection of stand/booth erection and storage area will be completed prior to commencing sales.
10. Except during the periods when fireworks are being sold, they shall at all times be maintained in a safety container that meets the approval of the Fire Marshal. The safety container shall be located either outside of the City or if within the City, at a location within the Industrial zoning district. The address of the storage site shall be provided to the City and access for inspection shall be available upon request. No storage of fireworks shall be permitted at any other locations within the City of Gonzales. The applicant shall make any changes to the container or location that may be requested for safety purposes by the Fire Marshal.

- Storage to be no less than 100 feet from inhabited buildings
- Storage to be no more than 1000 pounds of fireworks
- Type of approved storage containers:
  - Type 1 Magazines shall be a permanent structure such as a building, igloo, tunnel or dugout. It shall be bullet resistant, fire resistant, weather resistant, theft resistant and ventilated.
  - Type 2 Magazine shall be a box, trailer, semitrailer or other mobile facility. It shall be bullet resistant, fire resistant, weather resistant, theft resistant and ventilated.
  - Type 3 Magazine shall be a “day box” or other portable magazine. It shall be theft resistant, fire resistant and weather resistant.
  - Type 4 Magazine shall be a permanent, portable or mobile structure, such as a building, igloo, box, semitrailer or other mobile container, which shall be fire resistant, theft resistant and weather resistant.

11. Clear vegetation from parking lot to road base no less than 100 feet.  
Provide a water supply at site.
